The Jae Kim Vision Scholarship Program

Each year, Four (4) \$2,500 Jae Kim Vision Scholarships will be awarded to Bogopa employees or their children (\$10,000 maximum limit per person over 4 years). Scholarship can be renewed until recipients earn their degree up to the maximum amount.

The Jae Kim Vision Scholarship Program is underwritten by Food Bazaar Supermarkets and Bogopa Service Corp. It is through this scholarship program that Bogopa/Food Bazaar recognizes students and their commitment to their education and communities. The Jae Kim Vision Scholarship Program enables deserving applicants throughout the area to receive various levels of scholarships to help defray the cost of their post-secondary education. The program is managed by Bogopa's Scholarship Committee.

Program Eligibility

To be eligible for The Jae Kim Vision Scholarship Program, a student must:

- Be a part-time employee at Bogopa for at least 5 years, or a full-time employee at Bogopa for no less than 3 years (or the child of a such an employee).
- Be planning to enroll (no later than the Fall semester following announcement of awards) in a full- or part-time course of study at an accredited 2- or 4-year conventional or online college, university, or vocational/technical school in the United States.
- Have maintained at least a cumulative 2.7 Grade Point Average (GPA) on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent).
- Be a full-time resident of the Food Bazaar marketing area, which includes New York City, Long Island, New Jersey and Connecticut.

Rules & Regulations

Students must complete the application/essay and submit it by the deadline of May 31st. Applications are evaluated on the information provided; therefore, it is important to answer each question as completely as possible.

All information submitted is confidential and will be reviewed by Bogopa's Scholarship Committee.

These scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, age, religion, creed, sex, disability or national origin.

Awards are for undergraduate, graduate, or vocational/technical study. If the candidate is awarded the scholarship, their parent (or they themselves) must remain employed by Bogopa Service Corporation for 1 year after receiving the award, otherwise the award must be paid back.

If the candidate wishes to continue receiving the award each year (for up to four years), he/she must fill out the continuing scholarship application each summer and their parent (or they themselves) must remain employed by Bogopa Service Corporation for 1 year after receiving the award otherwise the award must be paid back. The monies may be used only for tuition, fees, books or supplies. The scholarship must be used during the academic year for which it is awarded.

Associates of Bogopa and/or dependents of Bogopa associates or management are eligible to participate in the program.

Bogopa's Scholarship Committee will notify recipients no later than June 15th of each year by mail or email, and all recipients' names will be posted in Food Bazaar supermarkets. Recipients must verify their enrollment at a post-secondary institution.

Awards will be processed by Bogopa Service Corp on behalf of Food Bazaar Supermarkets. Checks will be mailed directly to each recipient's home address in mid-August. Checks are made payable to the student. Students must inform Bogopa's Scholarship Committee of any changes in address, school enrollment or other pertinent information.

Scholarship recipients have no obligation to Food Bazaar Supermarkets or Bogopa Service Corp. This program is administered in accordance with IRS regulations

La Visión de Jae Kim

Programa de Becas

Cada año, se otorgarán cuatro (4) becas de \$ 2,500 Jae Kim Vision a los empleados de Bogopa o sus hijos (límite máximo de \$ 10,000 por persona durante 4 años). Las becas se pueden renovar hasta que los beneficiarios obtengan su título hasta la cantidad máxima.

El Programa de Becas Jae Kim Vision está suscrito por Food Bazaar Supermarkets y Bogopa Service Corp. Es a través de este programa de becas que Bogopa / Food Bazaar reconoce a los estudiantes y su compromiso con su educación y comunidades. El programa de becas Jae Kim Vision permite que los solicitantes que lo merezcan en toda el área reciban varios niveles de becas para ayudar a sufragar el costo de su educación postsecundaria. El programa es administrado por el Comité de Becas de Bogopa.

Elegibilidad del programa

Para ser elegible para el programa de becas The Jae Kim Vision, un estudiante debe:

- Ser un empleado a tiempo parcial en Bogopa durante al menos 5 años, o un empleado a tiempo completo en Bogopa por no menos de 3 años (o el hijo de un empleado de ese tipo).
- Estar planeando inscribirse (antes del semestre de otoño siguiente al anuncio de los premios) en un curso de tiempo completo o parcial en un colegio acreditado de 2 o 4 años convencional o en línea, universidad o escuela vocacional / técnica en los Estados Unidos.
- Haber mantenido al menos un promedio acumulativo de 2.7 puntos (GPA) en una escala de 4.0 (o equivalente).
- Ser un residente de tiempo completo del área de comercialización de Food Bazaar, que incluye Nueva York, Long Island, Nueva Jersey y Connecticut.

Reglas y regulaciones

Los estudiantes deben completar la solicitud / ensayo y enviarla antes de la fecha límite del 30 de abril. Las aplicaciones se evalúan con la información proporcionada; por lo tanto, es importante responder cada pregunta lo más completamente posible.

Toda la información presentada es confidencial y será revisada por el Comité de Becas de Bogopa.

Estas becas se otorgan sin distinción de raza, color, edad, religión, credo, sexo, discapacidad u origen nacional.

Los premios son para estudios de pregrado, postgrado o vocacional / técnico. Si el candidato recibe la beca, sus padres (o ellos mismos) deben ser empleados por Bogopa Service Corporation durante 1 año después de recibir la beca; o, la beca debe devolverse.

Si el candidato desea continuar recibiendo el premio cada año (hasta cuatro años), debe completar la solicitud de beca continua cada verano y sus padres (o ellos mismos) deben permanecer empleados por Bogopa Service Corporation durante 1 año después de recibir el premio, de lo contrario, el premio debe ser reembolsado. El dinero puede usarse solo para matrícula, cuotas, libros o suministros. La beca debe ser utilizada durante el año académico para el cual se otorga.

Los asociados de Bogopa y / o dependientes de los asociados o la administración de Bogopa son elegibles para participar en el programa.

El Comité de Becas de Bogopa notificará a los destinatarios a más tardar el 15 de mayo de cada año por correo postal o electrónico, y todos los nombres de los destinatarios se publicarán en los supermercados de Food Bazaar. Los destinatarios deben verificar su inscripción en una institución postsecundaria.

Los premios serán procesados por Bogopa Service Corp en nombre de Food Bazaar Supermarkets. Los cheques se enviarán por correo postal directamente a la dirección de cada destinatario a mediados de agosto. Los cheques son pagaderos al estudiante. Los estudiantes deben informar al Comité de Becas de Bogopa de cualquier cambio en la dirección, la inscripción escolar u otra información pertinente.

Los beneficiarios de las becas no tienen ninguna obligación con Food Bazaar Supermarkets o Bogopa Service Corp. Este programa se administra de acuerdo con las reglamentaciones del IRS.
